## Heroes of Savannah School Re-Opened



The Heroes of Savannah School re-opened on May 19. As of May 31, we have 121 students attending classes at Heroes of Savannah school. The school year will continue until August.



As the picture at left shows, the building at the Heroes of Savannah school appeared undamaged by the earthquake. The HOS building was built with a heavy concrete roof so that a second floor could be added as enrollment increased.

The authorities have determined that buildings with heavy concrete roofs cannot be used for classrooms. If that type of roof collapsed in an aftershock or another earthquake, the results would be catastrophic. As a result, we had temporary classrooms (like those at Marechal School) constructed so that we could re-open the school.

Since the rains began, it has become imperative that we build a temporary classroom for the pre-schoolers. This has been done and the little ones now have their own classroom "building."

His house in Marechal was severely damaged in the earthquake and now that the rains have come his situation has become much more difficult.

## Sue Witt Reports from Port au Prince Orphanage



Her house continues to settle more with each aftershock. Now she has two steel doors that will not close. This presents a serious security problem.

The five little girls at the orphanage are back at school—their Port au Prince school is being held in a tent, so it is very hot! Sue also reports that the children are also going to a small church nearby: Sunday School from 6 until 8 am; then church from 8 am til 10 am!

## FINANCIAL REPORT

The International Village of Hope has \$59,255.11 in all accounts as of May 31, 2010.

Almost half of the March-May expenses were for emergency items needed because of the earthquake: Tents, demolition of the kitchen/classroom building at Marechal School and construction of temporary classrooms at both schools.

The “regular” budget for the 2010-2011 school year is also shown below. This budget does not include any items for rebuilding or for emergency supplies or items. Those expenses will be over and above the budgeted amounts.

The “regular” budget is about \$10,000 higher than the 2009-2010 “regular” budget due to the increase in the minimum wage for teachers.
